



Luke 5:4 When He had finished speaking, He said to Simon, "Launch out into the deep and let down your nets for a catch." Simon answered Him, "Master, we have worked all night and have caught nothing. But at Your word I will let down the net." When they had done this, they caught a great number of fish, and their net was tearing. So they signaled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both boats, so that they began to sink.

Luke 5:8 When Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Depart from me, for I am a sinful man, O Lord." For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish which they had taken, ¹⁰ and so were James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. Then Jesus said to Simon, "Do not fear. From now on you will catch men." ¹¹ So when they had brought their boats to land, they left everything and followed Him.

Matthew 19:16 Now one came and said to Him, "Good Teacher, what good deed shall I do to have eternal life?"¹⁷He replied to him, "Why do you call Me good? There is One who is good. But if you would enter life, keep the commandments."¹⁸He said to Him, "Which ones?" Jesus said, "You shall not murder, You shall not commit adultery, You shall not steal, You shall not bear false witness, ¹⁹Honor your father and your mother, and, You shall love your neighbor as yourself."

Matthew 19:20 The young man said to Him, "All these I have kept from my youth. What do I still lack?"²¹Jesus said to him, "If you would be perfect, go and sell what you have, and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. And come, follow Me."²²But when the young man heard this, he went away sorrowful. For he had great possessions.

Romans 10:8 But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart." This is the word of faith that we preach: "that if you confess with your mouth Jesus is Lord, and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved, "for with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Romans 10:11 For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes in Him will not be ashamed." For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is generous toward all who call upon Him. For, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

John 16:8 When He comes, He will convict the world of sin and of righteousness and of judgment: of sin, because they do not believe in Me;

Luke 22:31 Then the Lord said, "Simon, Simon, listen! Satan has demanded to have you to sift you as wheat. ³²But I have prayed for you that your faith may not fail. And when you have repented, strengthen your brothers." ³³He said to Him, "Lord, I am ready to go with You to prison and to death." ³⁴He said, "I tell you, Peter, before the rooster crows today, you will deny three times that you know Me."

Luke 22:54 Then they arrested Him, and led Him away, and brought Him into the high priest's house. Peter followed at a distance. ⁵⁵But when they had kindled a fire in the middle of the courtyard and sat down together, Peter sat among them. ⁵⁶Then a servant girl saw him as he sat near the fire, and gazed at him, and said, "This man was with Him." ⁵⁷But he denied Him, saying, "Woman, I do not know Him." ⁵⁸A little later someone else saw him and said, "You also are one of them." Peter said, "Man, I am not!"

Luke 22:59 About an hour later another man firmly declared, "Certainly, this man also was with Him, for he is a Galilean." Peter said, "Man, I do not know what you are saying." Immediately, while he was yet speaking, the rooster crowed. The Lord turned and looked at Peter. Then Peter remembered the word of the Lord, how He had told him, "Before the rooster crows, you will deny Me three times." And Peter went outside and wept bitterly.

Romans 7:15 For what I am doing, I do not understand, for I do not practice what I will to do, but I do the very thing I hate. ¹⁶But if I practice what I do not will to do, I agree with the law that it is good. ¹⁷So now it is no longer I that do it, but sin that dwells in me. ¹⁸For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) dwells no good thing, for the will to do what is right is present with me, but how to perform what is good I do not find. ¹⁹For the good I desire to do, I do not do, but the evil I do not want is what I do. ²⁰Now if I do what I do not want, it is no longer I who does it, but sin that lives in me.

Romans 8:38 For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, neither angels nor principalities nor powers, neither things present nor things to come,³⁹ neither height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

John 21:15 So when they had eaten breakfast, Jesus said to Simon Peter, "Simon, son of John, do you love Me more than these?" He said to Him, "Yes, Lord. You know that I love You." He said to him, "Feed My lambs." He said to him again a second time, "Simon, son of John, do you love Me?" He said to Him, "Yes, Lord. You know that I love You." He said to him, "Tend My sheep." He said to him the third time, "Simon, son of John, do you love Me?" Peter was grieved because He asked him the third time, "Do you love Me?" He said to Him, "Lord, You know everything. You know that I love You." Jesus said to him, "Feed My sheep."

John 21:18 "Truly, truly I say to you, when you were young, you dressed yourself and walked where you desired. But when you are old, you will stretch out your hands, and another will dress you and carry you where you do not want to go." He said this, signifying by what kind of death he would glorify God. When He had said this, He said to him, "Follow Me."

John 21:20 Peter turned and saw following them the disciple whom Jesus loved, who also leaned against His bosom at the supper and had said, "Lord, who is it that is going to betray You?" When Peter saw him, he said to Jesus, "Lord, what about this man?" Jesus said to him, "If it is My will that he remain until I come, what is that to you? Follow Me!"

Acts 4:18 Then they called them and commanded them not to speak or teach at all in the name of Jesus. ¹⁹ But Peter and John answered them, "Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you more than to God, you judge. ²⁰ For we cannot help but declare what we have seen and heard." ²¹ When they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding no way to punish them, because of the people. For all glorified God for what was done.

2 Peter 3:14 Therefore, beloved, since you are waiting for these things, be diligent that you may be found by Him in peace, spotless and blameless.

2 Peter 3:17 You therefore, beloved, since you know these things beforehand, beware lest you also fall from your own firm footing, being led away by the deception of the wicked. But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be glory, both now and forever. Amen.
